Shottesbrooke 2006 Shiraz

RATING – 92 POINTS

The 2006 Shiraz spent 12 months in American oak hogsheads. It is dark ruby-colored with an alluring, slightly kinky perfume of wood smoke, spice box, leather, game, and blueberry. On the palate it is smooth-textured, full-bodied, and plush, with layers of savory flavors. It has enough structure to evolve for 3-4 years and will be at its best from 2012 to 2020.
